City of La Porte – Monroe Manor Sewer Separation - Phases 2&3

Sealed Bids for the construction of the Monroe Manor Sewer Separation - Phases 2&3 will be received by the City of La Porte – Board of Public Works at 801 Michigan Ave, La Porte, IN 46350 until 3 pm local time on April 30, 2021 at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read aloud. The Project consists of the total reconstruction of Glenview, Parkview, Lawndale, Eastwood and Silverbrook Avenues in the Monroe Manor Subdivision in the City of La Porte. The project will be bid with a base bid containing several of the streets. The remaining streets will be bid as alternates separated per street to allow for award based on funding available. The total project contains the reconstruction of up to approximately 4,000 lineal feet of roadway including the installation and or replacement of ductile iron water main, gravity storm and sanitary sewers, sanitary and water services, concrete curb and gutter, concrete sidewalk, concrete aprons, asphalt paving, grass restoration, tree plantings and all other work within the City of La Porte.

Bids will be received for a single prime Contract. Bids shall be on a unit price basis. Two (2) copies of the sealed Bids bearing the project name as well as the name and address of the bidder shall be submitted to Courtney Parthun, City of La Porte – City Clerk, 801 Michigan Ave, La Porte, IN 46350.

A certified check, cashier's check or bid bond in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the total amount of the bid will be required with each bid as security for the proper execution of the contract. A 100% Labor, Material, and Performance Bond will be required of successful bidder. Bidder shall submit Indiana State Form 96, the City of La Porte Affidavit of Compliance and be certified to do work in the State of Indiana and the City of La Porte. Additional Bidding requirements are in the Instructions to bidders included in the Project Documents.

No Pre-Bid Meeting will be held for this project.

No bid shall be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days after the scheduled opening without consent of the OWNER. The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all bids, waive any informality in bidding or to accept the bid, consistent with law, which best serves the interest of the Owner.
